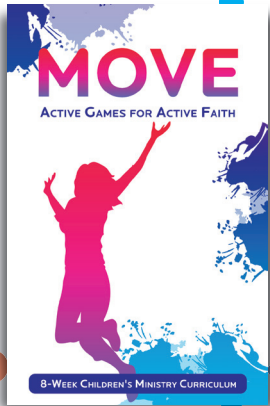

#### IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

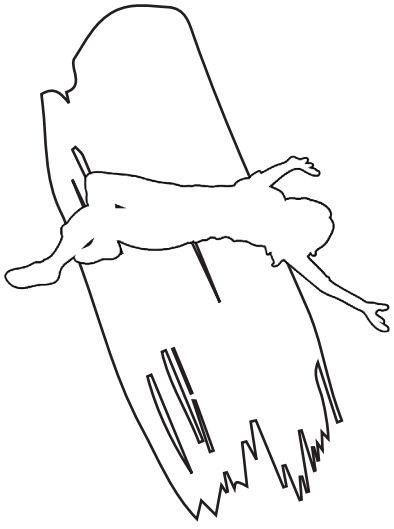
#### PARENT TIME:

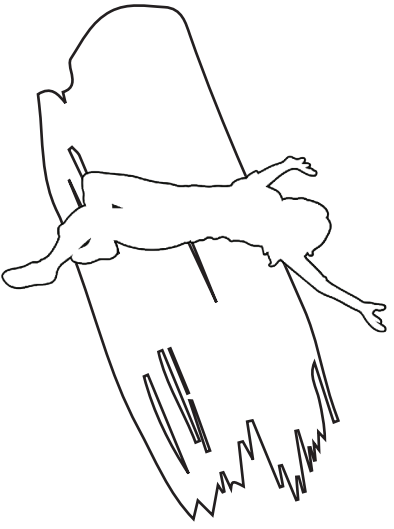
## CRAFT ACTIVITY

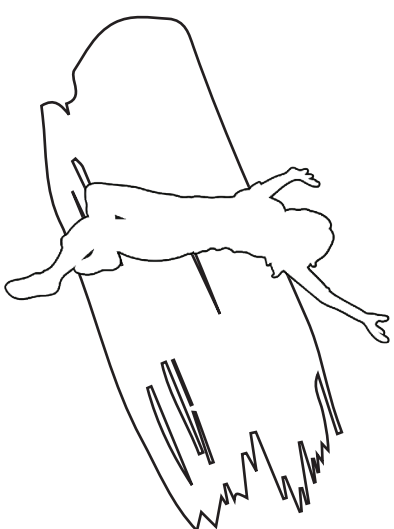

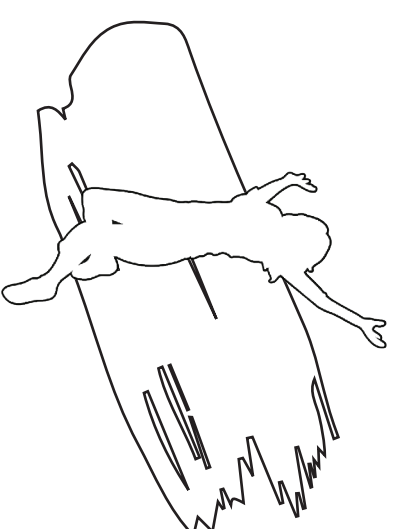
